MESSAGE FROM THE CEO AND BOARD CHAIR

We are very proud of the tremendous contributions which the Forum for Women Entrepreneurs (FWE) has made to the entrepreneurial landscape in Canada over the past year. This year was significant for FWE in many ways, from a leadership transition to growth of its programming and the number of women entrepreneurs supported across Canada. The passionately dedicated team and Board continue to be committed to enabling women entrepreneurs in Canada to be #wildlysuccessful, and to leave no woman behind.

When we think about the impact FWE has had this year, a few key highlights come to mind. After a successful pilot of Juventas last year – our E-Series stream for young women aged 16-29 – this year Juventas was established as an ongoing program component and launched in both Toronto and Vancouver thanks to the pivotal support of RBC Foundation's Future Launch Program. Over 30 young women across Canada benefited from this targeted education and support. Overall, the E-Series and Mentor Program both grew significantly over the year, serving more women and involving the support of generous speakers, educators and mentors. This year, for the first time, we also launched an in-person event for Pitch for the Purse in Toronto- the Semi-Finals event, in addition to the Vancouver Semi-Finals. Gathering both investors and entrepreneurs for an inspiring and energizing evening, the Semi-Finals hold an opportunity to learn about new businesses and the women entrepreneurs behind them.

The 17th annual Odlum Brown FWE Gala was a roaring success, welcoming its largest audience and achieving its highest raise yet thanks to the tremendous generosity of our Gala Committee and our sponsors

and supporters. This Gala also hosted the 3rd Pitch for the Purse Finale, where three incredible entrepreneurs shared their vision for their businesses: Patrice Mousseau of Satya Organics, Jessica Oblak of Copper Medical and Sonia Strobel of Skipper Otto's Community Supported Fishery, with Sonia taking home the winning title and \$25,000. We also had the incredible delight of welcoming remarks from the Honourable Minister Mary Ng and the Honourable Lieutenant Governor Janet Austin.

FWE has been growing its external partnerships and collaborations. We are very lucky that in Canada, and particularly in BC, the ecosystem of support organizations for women is very much alive and thriving.

We have continued our work as co-chair of the WEB Alliance and forged new partnerships such as becoming a member of Canada's new Women Entrepreneurship Knowledge Hub. These partnerships brought about many new opportunities for impact, such as hosting a Marketplace featuring booths from women entrepreneurs in our community at the world's largest gender equality conference – Women Deliver – thanks to our partners and champions at Teck Resources.

Unquestionably, FWE's impact is thanks to its people. This year held many shifts for FWE around its team. Firstly, we need to acknowledge the transition of our incredible founder, Christina Anthony. Christina's vision and energy were the driving force behind FWE since its inception in 2002. We are tremendously grateful for her contributions and are delighted that she will continue to support the organization as Gala Co-Chair and Chair Emeritus. We welcomed in as Chair Judy Brooks, who has been supporting and in leadership

with FWE for many years, and we have no doubt that with her guidance and energy, FWE will continue to create deep impact. We also want to acknowledge the new Board members that joined us: Val Litwin, James Hatton, Ravy Mehroke and Nicole Smith, and thank the Board members whose terms wrapped up with us: Elizabeth Harrison and Nicole Stefenelli. The team also experienced change. We want to thank Larkin MacKenzie-Ast for her leadership as Executive Director for the past two years, and recognize the new incredible team members we welcomed in: Erika Thomas, Kate Duggan and Gaby Rice. We were also thrilled to have new leadership join – Paulina Cameron became our CEO in January and Monica Murray held the role of Advisor and Acting CEO for part of the year during Paulina's maternity leave. Their contributions deeply supported the team during this time of transition and enabled FWE to continue delivering exceptional value to its community. We'd be remiss to also not acknowledge the tremendous support FWE receives from hundreds of volunteers, mentors, contractors and speakers, whose contribution to the organization is invaluable. 



PITCH FOR THE PURSE

In its third year, the Pitch for the Purse program received a hugely positive response both in applications to the Program and interest in supporting our women entrepreneurs. We received over 120 applications from across Canada, which were narrowed down to a top 30 for consideration by our experienced review panel. 12 Semi-Finalists were chosen to move forward: four in Toronto and eight in Vancouver.



Our Judge Mentors Ali Pejman, Brian Paes-Braga, and Sophia Maizel faced the hard task of selecting three final ventures to move forward to the finale. FWE was proud to support Patrice Mousseau of Satya Organics, Jessica Oblak of Copper Medical Inc, and Sonia Strobel of Skipper Otto's Community Supported Fishery at the grand Finale at the Odlum Brown FWE Gala on February 21, 2019. The Finalists shared their visions in front of our 650 person audience and our two Expert Judges Amar Doman and Kate Ross LeBlanc, and then the audience live voted to pick the 2019 Pitch for the Purse winner: Sonia Strobel of Skipper Otto's Community Supported Fishery.







